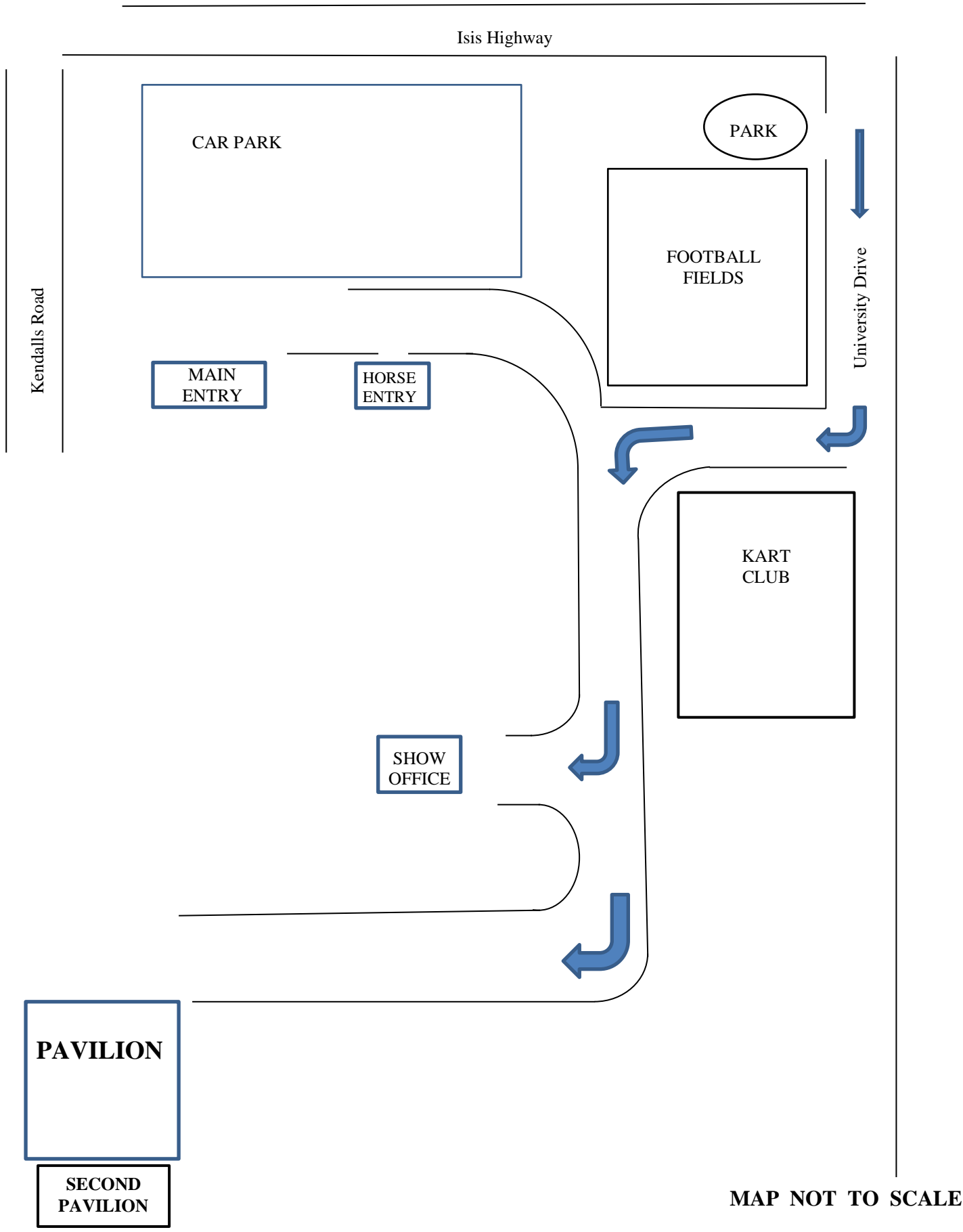

## SECTION 31 HARD HANDCRAFTS

2. THERE WILL BE A LIMIT OF ONLY THREE (3) ENTRIES PER CLASS PER EXHIBITOR.
3. NO Exhibit can be entered into more than one class.
4. Entries must not have been entered in any previous Bundaberg Show.
5. Each and every Exhibit must have been completed within 12 months prior to the first day of the Show.
6. Class ticket must be attached to bottom of exhibit by sticky tape.
7. A sealed envelope containing the name and address of the exhibitor must be attached to the back of every piece of work.
8. Classes 31/1 & 31/2 - Entry Form must be signed by teacher and must state grade.
9. ENTRIES CLOSE Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May at 4.00pm.
10. EXHIBITS TO BE DELIVERED TO THE MAIN PAVILION ON SUNDAY 26<sup>th</sup> MAY BETWEEN 10am to 12pm.
11. Exhibits to be collected Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> June, between 9am and 11am.
12. EACH PIECE ENTERED MUST BE THE BONA FIDE WORK OF THE ENTRANT, AND CAN NOT HAVE BEEN COMPLETED WHILST IN A CLASS SITUATION OR WHILST BEING SUPERVISED AND MUST BE SPECIFIED SIZE AS PER SCHEDULE.
