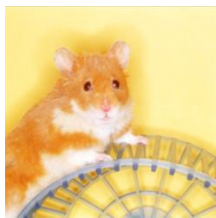

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Late entries will **NOT** be accepted.
2. All exhibits must have official class sticker attached.
3. Class stickers are to be affixed to the left ear of the cavy or the front left of the show board.
4. All entries will be judged on equal terms.
5. **ENTRIES CLOSE:** Friday 17th May at 4.00 pm.
6. Entries to be lodged at **THE SECRETARY'S OFFICE, SHOWGROUNDS** via **UNIVERSITY DRIVE, BUNDABERG.**
7. **Exhibits to be delivered** to the **PAVILION (to be advised)** on **THURSDAY 30th MAY** and set up by 9am. ***Details of entry to grounds will be given out when entry forms are lodged.*** Judging commences at 9.30am. Exhibitors need to supply their own show boards / mats. Pet entries are judged during the lunch break commencing approx. 12 noon.
8. **Prize money** to be collected from the Show Office over the show period Wednesday to Friday. After the show, prize money may be collected from the Show Office between 9am and 2pm until 7th June. Thereafter Ph 4155 0802

General Classes

Cavies entered in these classes must conform to the Australian National Cavy Council INC.

Junior Exhibitor Classes

This class is for Junior Exhibitors aged 18 & under. Cavies must be exhibited and owned by a junior member, and must also be entered in the respective General Class.

Novice Handler Class

The novice class is for novice exhibitors, (in your first 12 months of exhibiting). It is a beginners class to learn how to exhibit and prepare your cavies for the show tables.. Exhibitors are advised on the finer points of showing. Cavies must be exhibited/owned by the NOVICE member in all classes.

Unstandardised Class

This class is for new breeds that have been granted "Developing breed" or "a working title" from the Standards Review Panel, but do not yet have a recognized standard accepted by the ANCC.

Cavies are presented for discussion, no awards are given. There is no entry fee for this class.

Condition Class

Eligible for all cavies. Standard breed or mixed breed Cavies can be entered in these classes. Judged on cleanliness, condition, presentation and temperament. Cavies entered in the General breed classes are not eligible to enter.

Entries

Entry Fees & Payment

\$10 exhibitors fee and then each cavy entered fees \$2 per class. Entry forms and fees are to be lodged by the closing date. Fees are applicable to all entries. Scratching and/or withdrawal of entry will not be refunded. *\$10 exhibitor fee only applies to pedigree exhibits.*

Unable to attend / withdrawal of entry

Any entry withdrawals (scratchings) must be reported to the steward by the Friday before the show date. If you are unable to make the show please advise the steward you will be absent.
