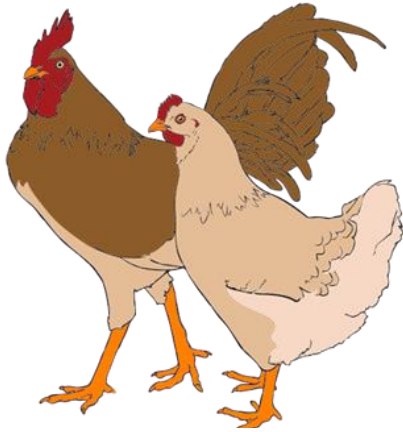

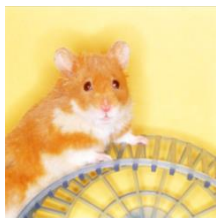

## Section 5 POULTRY

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

**.Refer General Rules of Competition at back of Schedule.**

- . Late entries or substitute birds will not be accepted.
- . There will be no limit of entries.
- . No exhibit can be entered in more than one class.
- . Any bird dyed or in any way interfered with will be disqualified and the exhibitor dealt with as the Committee may think fit.
- . Any person found removing eggs from the coops in the show shall be prosecuted.
- . All eggs are the property of the Show Society.
- . Should any dispute arise for which no specific rule is laid down, the matter will be referred to the Committee, whose decision shall be final.
- . Weight of pit game to be the responsibility of the exhibitor.
- . Exhibits must be presented clean, free of disease and vermin.
- . All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at the time of entry.
- . Exhibits will be fed by the Society, without charge to the exhibitor.
- . Judging will be open to the public.
- . Young bird's category - cockerel & pullet (no older than 12 months) will be up to the decision of the judge.
- . For delivery of exhibits and collection of same, entry to the grounds may be gained through the Kendalls Road Gate, where a list of all bona fide exhibitors will be kept. Only persons on this list will be admitted.
- . Sale of poultry at the Show will include (10% of price paid to the Show Society).
- . No attendants' passes will be issued on this section.
- . **ENTRIES CLOSE FRIDAY 12<sup>th</sup> May at 4.00 pm.**
- . Exhibits to be delivered to Poultry Pavilion Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> May between 2.00 pm & 8.00 pm.
- . Exhibits to be collected on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May between 2.30pm & 5.00pm. Refer to Chief Steward for collection details.

**Prize money** to be collected from Show Office on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> May and Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May (between 10.00 and 2.00). **Refer to Chief Steward for collection details.**

After the show, prize money may be collected from the Show Office between 9am & 4pm until 3<sup>rd</sup> June. Thereafter Ph 4155 0802.

## **SECTION 6 -** **CANARIES, FINCHES, BUDGERIGARS, PARROTS** **QUAILS & DOVES** **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. Refer General Conditions of Entry & Competition at the back of Schedule.
2. There will be no limit of entries.
3. No exhibit can be entered in more than one class.
4. All exhibits must have official class sticker attached.
5. Class stickers are to be affixed to the highest portion of the bottom board on the front of the cage at the LEFT HAND SIDE, other than budgerigars who will have their stickers affixed to the RIGHT HAND SIDE. No distinguishing marks may appear on the cage.
6. All exhibits shall be exhibited in STANDARD SHOW CAGES. For birds without Standard Show Cages, please use a suitable cage.
7. No birds shall be removed until after closing of the Show, without the sanction of the Chief Steward.
8. All cage bird exhibitors must provide sufficient food and water for 24 hours.
9. Cages to have floors covered with coarse grit or sand or seed.
10. The Judge shall be empowered to decline to award a Champion in any class in which specimens are not, in his opinion, of sufficient merit. No birds will be awarded any prize, unless the Judge considers it worthy. No discussion will be entered into.
11. All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at the time of entry. Any person infringing this rule by any device, shall forfeit all entry fees and prize money.
12. Prizes to be awarded based on the relevant Australian Standard where applicable.
13. For delivery of exhibits and collection of same (refer to Steward for collection procedures), entry to the grounds may be gained via University Drive.
14. Definition of Classes - **CLEAR** - Clear, without handling; **HEAVILY VARIEGATED** - Dark colour to predominate; **LIGHTLY VARIEGATED** - Light colour to predominate.
15. **ENTRIES CLOSE:** Friday, 26<sup>th</sup> May 2017 at 4.00 pm. No late entries accepted.
16. Exhibits to be delivered to the Bird pavilion on Tuesday, 30<sup>th</sup> May 2017 between 5 pm & 8 pm.
17. Exhibits to be collected on Friday 3<sup>RD</sup> June 2017 between 4pm and 6pm, refer to Chief Steward.
18. For sale of birds (exhibitors' birds only), birds on show bench will not be released before close of show, 10% of sale to Show Society.

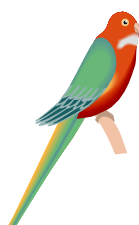

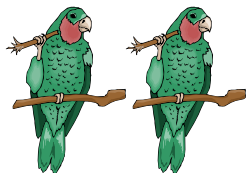
